Northwest Pipeline LLC (Northwest), an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of Williams Partners, L.P. (Williams), owns and operates an existing interstate natural gas pipeline system, extending from New Mexico's San Juan Basin to the border of Canada in Sumas, Washington. For more than 60 years, Williams' Northwest system has been a primary artery for the transmission of natural gas to the Pacific Northwest and Intermountain Region.

To meet the growing demands for natural gas in the North Seattle market area, Williams is proposing the North Seattle Lateral Upgrade Project (Project) located in Snohomish County in the state of Washington.
